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
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One Vision One Heart A Journey to Excellence 宏愿在望 齐心出发

Not forgetting the history of Southern University College, we will continue to work with local Chinese Independent Schools and assist them in training their students and teachers. We would be the partner to the local Chinese Communities to ensure the continuation of the ideology of the Founders of Southern University College who had set up this institution in 1970s.

This year, for the first time, Southern University College held its Southern Carnival, which lasted for a week. As the new semester was about to begin, the carnival served to introduce to the community and new students about the range of activities being done by the different faculties, so that they could understand the university better.

It began with a prelude of fun through celebration of the Mid-Autumn Festival at Jump Party. This was followed by a golf tournament on Malaysia Day for fundraising in support of the university. The next three days were a series of exhibitions, competitions, tournaments, talks, and workshops, organised by different faculties. The semester then commenced with a ceremony. At the end of the week, Southern UC Walk was held to raise funds for the university and for all participants to have fun together while exercising.

This Feature Report describes all that happened in the eventful Carnival week.

The Mid-Autumn Festival is one of the most important celebrations in the Chinese lunar calendar. It continually reminds us of the famous tale of love, loyalty, sacrifice, and devotion, along with courage in the face of danger. Every year in Southern University College, Jump Party is organised to commemorate this important festival and to provide various cultural activities and entertainment.

On 14th September 2019, the 9th annual Jump Party Festival was held on the campus. The theme of this year's Mid-Autumn Festival is *Ban Yue*, which literally means accompanying the moon in Chinese. The night event had the whole campus lit up with lanterns hanging around everywhere. In addition, several students from the Department of Chinese dressed in Hanfu to perform traditional rituals.

Diversity in Activities

The varied activities and sites attracted many lecturers, staff, students, and members of the public to have fun together. The organising committee set up not only a large stage for performances, but also many activities in the Cultural Street, games, and a foodie street.

At the Cultural Street, there were booths for 24 Festival Drums, Chinese paper cutting art, archery, Chinese chess and Go, Chinese water colourart, Chinese calligraphy, and Indian henna. Interested visitors were encouraged to try their hands on these even though they were not skillful in them. More importantly, they learnt to appreciate the rich traditions of Chinese culture.

There were modern games that included a toy catching machine, basketball machine, and

an escape room for those who seek for horror games and adrenaline rush. Those who did not play any game or watch any performance, also had a whale of a time by hanging out with friends in the foodie street. There were many food stalls to choose from. While most of the food were Chinese food, halal food stalls were also introduced for the first time. The aroma of delicious food surrounded the campus while those events were going.

On the other hand, in the Multi Purpose Hall, there were booths selling different kinds of products, including clothes, cosmetics, handmade soft toys, handicrafts, plants, jewellery, and keychains.

Performances on Stage

A large stage flanked by jade rabbit figures was set up at the parking space to be the centre of performances of the festival. Lion dance, drum performance, and lighting ceremony with a huge lotus, commenced the event.

The performances were varied. There was a drama based on the tale of Chang'e and how she came to dwell on the Moon after swallowing the elixir of immortality.

There were also modern dance performances by students and children. The latter danced to various kinds of songs, including Chinese, Malay, Indian, and Western songs, making the celebration of Chinese tradition more multicultural.

Lastly, there were also singing performances by students and famous local singer Zhuang Xue Zhong, who was invited to sing many classical pop songs to entertain the audience.

Regarding to the large space between the Main Building and the Multi Purpose Hall, he said, it was for the Matchmaking activity and Foodie King competition. For the Foodie King competition, they did look for sponsors, but they tried to spend as little money as possible to let people have the opportunity to taste various kinds of delicious food. The culturally inclined ceremony might have noticed that some female students could be seen dressed in Hanfu. That was because the Department of Chinese organised the moon-worshipping ceremony, which is an ancient tradition of Mid-Autumn Festival. The term "Moon-worshipping" does not refer to the worship of the Moon itself, but to the worship of the Goddess of Moon, Chang'e.

According to custom, only females are allowed to perform this ritual. They offer their prayers and oblations for family harmony and the hope of finding their destined life partners as soon as possible.

Students and the public came to find out more about Southern UC through these light hearted events.

From the 17th to the 19th of September, in Dato' Seri Joseph Chong Multi-Purpose Hall, there were exhibitions organised by the Faculty of Education & Psychology, the Faculty of Chinese Medicine, the Faculty of Engineering & Information Technology, and the Faculty of Art & Design.

Improving Education through Understanding Psychology

The Faculty of Education & Psychology organised exhibitions through posters on child pedagogy, career counselling, major depressive disorder, autism spectrum disorder (ASD), schizophrenia, generalised anxiety disorder (GAD), the negative influences of digital devices to young children, as well as renowned educational psychologists such as Albert Bandura, Jean Piaget, and Jerome S. Bruner. There were also ingenious handmade projects that can be used to teach children kinaesthet-

ically instead of the usual method of reading from books.

Additionally, on the 17th of September, the Faculty organised a Kinaesthetic Activity and a Stress Ball Activity for students or participants to make kinaesthetically useful educational tools and stress balls. Along with this, there was also a heart rate test to find out if one's own heart rate is normal.

Emergency Drones and Sumo Robots

The Faculty of Engineering & Information Technology organised the Robotic Exhibition. The bronze medal winning team of CLAWAR 2019 (22nd International Conference on Climbing and Walking Robots and Support Technologies for Mobile Machines) came to showcase their first aid drones – Emergency Medical Response Drone (EMRD) and Emergency Aid Drone (EMERAID).

There was also a demonstration of how a drone can be controlled via brain-computer interface, that is, using the human brain to control the movements of the drone. Apart from this, there was also a demonstration called Sumo Robots, where small robots wrestled each other, the winner being the one that could successfully push the other robots out of the ring.


Additionally, on the 18th of September, the Faculty organised the 2019 Southern Tech Fest

Centre of Psychological and Counselling Services



Mental illness has become a non-negligible existence in our lives.

According to the Malaysia Mental Healthcare Performance Technical Report 2016, mental disorders was estimated to contribute for about 8.6% of total DALYs (referring to the total number of years lost to illness, disability, or premature death within a given population) (Ministry of Health [MOH], 2017).

In addition, the prevalence rate of mental health problem among adult and children in Malaysia were 29.2% and 12.1% respectively together with the increasing number of suicidal attempts (MOH, 2017). Despite the increasing number of mental health problem in Malaysia, the density of mental health professional is still low (MOH, 2017).

Besides, the Malaysian Health System Research report in year 2016 also indicated that mental illness is a leading cause of economic loss in several aspects due to direct and indirect health costs, absenteeism, low productivity while at work, and decreased income (The Star, 2019). As the number of mental health problems among Malaysian had increased by three-fold over the past 20 years, the cost of mental illness is expected to increase to RM99. 9billion (projected figure) in year 2030 (The Star, 2019).

The Centre of Psychological and Counselling Service is a subsidiary centre of Faculty of Education and Psychology, Southern University College. The development of this centre aims to provide affordable psychological and counselling services to the public. This centre will be run by clinical psychologist and registered counsellors who are also lecturers from the Department of Psychology and Counselling. The centre is expected to start operating in year 2020.

It is located at the Psychology and Counselling Laboratory, Level 4 of the International Education Building, Southern UC. At this moment, there are two individual counselling rooms for one-to-one psychotherapy or counselling session. The centre also equipped with one group therapy room and one playroom with one-way mirror.



Counsellors can observe children who are in the playroom through the one-way mirror.



There are two well-equipped counselling rooms for one-to-one psychotherapy.



Some suitable decorations and equipment are available.



Electronic equipment is also properly arranged for use.

The types of psychological and counselling services available are as below:

Psychological Assessment

Psychological assessment tests that are administered help to assess client's behaviour, personality, and capability. The assessments often involve the process of interview, observation, informal assessment, and the use of norm-referenced test, which is usually conducted by trained clinical psychologist. The assessments help the psychologist to measure and observe a client's behaviour which will later be used as the guide in intervention planning.

Psychotherapy/Counselling

Psychotherapy/counselling sessions will be conducted to clients in order to identify issues, crises, and encourage them to resolve the issues that cause distress. The sessions may be conducted in the form of one-to-one, family, and groups depending on the needs.

Psychoeducation

Apart from the abovementioned services, the centre also expects to deliver psychoeducation which is a method of education that provides information on mental health conditions to the clients and clients' family. This service aims to provide support to the clients and their family members for better understanding of the mental health condition, as well as managing and coping with the mental illness.

Prihatin Aspek Logistik Tangani Nahas Musim Perayaan

Saban tahun kita dihidangkan dengan ratusan angka kematian akibat kemalangan jalan raya tatkala menjelang musim perayaan. Adakah kita mengambil iktibar atau sekadar berasa simpati buat seketika sahaja. Hakikatnya, tahap keprihatinan dalam kalangan masyarakat masih rendah dan perkara ini menyebabkan tercetusnya malapetaka di atas jalan raya. Semua pihak harus memainkan peranan dalam usaha mengatasi masalah yang berlaku ini. Bagi pihak berwajib, kesemua kawasan yang sering berlakunya kemalangan maut harus diteliti punca nahas. Adakah fizikal jalan yang

mungkin berlubang, tidak rata atau rimbunan pokok yang menghalang papan tanda lalu lintas. Kadangkala terdapat jalan raya yang terlalu gelap pada waktu malam dan memerlukan cahaya sokongan bagi meningkatkan tahap penglihatan para pemandu.

Ironinya, kerja-kerja penambahbaikan jalan raya di negara ini sering kali dibuat secara besar-besaran tatkala menjelang musim pilihan raya. Mungkin pendekatan dan kaedah konvensional ini boleh diubah dan membuat penambahbaikan jalan raya menjelang musim



perayaan. Dalam pada itu, pihak kementerian yang berkenaan juga boleh memainkan peranan dengan menambahkan papan tanda peringatan serta etika pemanduan agar para pemandu memperoleh kesedaran dan memperbaiki etika pemanduan masing-masing. Penetapan peraturan kenderaan berat tidak dibenarkan untuk melalui lebuh raya utama kecuali bas sewaktu hari pertama dan kedua cuti perayaan wajar diteruskan bagi mengurangkan risiko kemalangan maut.

Sementara itu, penambahbaikan secara total dan efisien juga tidak akan memberi sebarang manfaat seandainya sikap para pemandu sendiri yang miskin etika. Umpamanya menggunakan lorong kecemasan sesuka hati, memotong barisan berkembar dan lebih parah berlumba sesama mereka. Minda sebegini

harus cuci demi menyelamatkan nyawa para pemandu lain di negara ini yang tidak bersalah. Kementerian komunikasi juga boleh memainkan peranan dengan memaparkan iklan di kaca televisyen berhubung persediaan keselamatan sebelum pulang ke kampung. Umpamanya seperti pemeriksaan bunga pada tayar kenderaan, sistem brek, minyak pelincir serta angin pada tayar simpanan. Kesemua elemen ini setidak-tidaknya dapat meningkatkan kesedaran dalam kalangan pemandu khususnya buat perantau yang jauh kampung halamannya.

Pada sisi lain, didapati terdapat segelintir kenderaan yang menggunakan lampu HID yang tinggi kuasanya lantas menyilaukan pandangan pemandu lain yang berada di hadapan atau berselisih dengan kenderaan mereka. Perkara ini tidak boleh dipandang



enteng berikutan boleh menyebabkan nahas jalan raya kerana secara saintifiknya, mata manusia yang terkena biasan silauan yang tinggi boleh kehilangan titik fokus dalam masa beberapa saat sebelum dapat melihat kembali secara normal. Situasi ini sangat-sangat tidak selamat bagi pemandu, penumpang mahupun pengguna jalan raya yang lain lebih-lebih lagi jika seseorang itu merupakan pemandu bus yang membawa hampir 40 nyawa di dalam kenderaannya. Perkara ini perlu di pandang serius oleh pihak berkuasa terutamanya menjelang musim perayaan pada bulan hadapan.

Akhir sekali, faktor alam sudah pasti tidak dapat dikesampingkan. Umpamanya hujan lebat, banjir dan tanah runtuh merupakan beberapa perkara yang setiap pamandu harus waspada. Pastikan setiap kenderaan mempunyai peti

keselamatan bagi tujuan rawatan awal jika berlaku sebarang kemalangan. Moga statistik kemalangan pada musim perayaan ini dapat dikurangkan dengan kerjasama semua pihak sama ada pihak berwajib mahupun para pemandu sendiri berlandaskan prinsip pematuhan etika pemanduan jalan raya di negara ini.

访三位校园活动主席





"我的活力校园"、"离开地球表面"中秋园游会、"家在南方"学生文艺大汇演都是近年来本校学生常年活动中的"重头戏"。今年"我的活力校园7.0之艺演南竞"及"离开地球表面9.0之伴月"中秋园游会结束后,紧接着的便是即将于11月20日迎来的"家在南方7.0之盼逆"。

本期《今日南方》于"家在南方"的筹办期间特别邀来今年这三大学生活动的主席,分别为许俊维、林联卫及李慧仪。由本次"家在南方"筹委会主席李慧仪提出在筹办活动上面对的疑难杂症,再由两位卸下大任的主席对症下药,为她解惑,也希望在未来筹办活动的同学能从中受益。

- 李: 你们好,我是这届"家在南方"的筹委会主席。这次很荣幸能跟两位主席前辈讨教。首先,想请问两位是怎么开始接触校内活动呢?为何会想参与筹办校内活动?
- 许: 会办活动是因为想传承学长姐们的精神, 希望让这些活动继续下去,越办越好,展 现更多不一样的方面。
- 林: 之前读专业文凭的时候,我是不参与任何 学校活动的,但我有参与其他校外的活 动。从去年开始我第一次参加"离开地球 表面"园游会才真正地开始认识学校的每 一个角落,也认识到了一些朋友,了解了 校内活动的筹办模式,然后就想继续传承 这些精神。
- 李: 原来是有这么深厚的意义。那你们会选择 性参与活动还是会觉得多多益善?
- 许: 我决定担任"活力校园"的主席也是考虑 了很久,但因为本身就比较喜欢参与活动,而且南院这个地方大家都很热情, 办活动都会让我学习到很多,都会有成就感,所以才会去办活动。
- 林: 其实我只做过几项活动,像是一次社团主席,第二次主席就是今年的"离开地球表面"园游会。我个人觉得在参与活动方面,不是你参与得越多越好,而是你在活动中学习到了什么。就是你在哪方面比较需要加强,你就需要去参与那方面的项目来弥补你的缺点。

李: 听说你们的成绩也很不错,所以你们怎样 确保课业和活动都达到平衡?

访退休"花王"李禹顺先生

还记得在本校服务长达15年的花王花后吗?

10月26日,本校退休"花王"李禹顺先生和8位画家于新加坡国家 图书馆戏剧中心举办为期3天的"2019年亚洲杰出书法与艺术新锐 展览会"。相关展出由新加坡艺术工具坊(TOOLART LLP)主办,其 中包括同样来自马来西亚的两位艺术家及新加坡、越南、印尼、 印度的艺术工作者。 展览当日,李禹顺先生的画作就摆放在展厅的 入口处,一踏入展厅便映入眼帘。从对农村生 活与家禽鱼虾栩栩如生的刻画, 到李先生自身 热爱的花卉植物, 再到朴实大气的山水画, 各 种自然景物跃然纸上。无师自通的精湛才艺让 策展人黄丽莲也对这位72岁的年长新晋艺术家 表示赞赏,并且认为他体现了乐龄人士勇于尝 试新事物的正面例子, 也给予年轻艺术家们深 刻的印象。

其实谦虚的李先生是在家人及黄丽莲的多番游 说下才鼓起勇气参与展出的。年轻时的他从事 建筑工作,后来在本校担任园艺组主任,与夫 人陈秀英女士一同栽种校园内的花草, 为南方 大学学院奉献多年汗水。他们的辛勤灌溉让众 人得以在优美景致下上班、学习。那些年百花 盛开、繁花锦簇的日子也是"花王"与"花 后"美丽的回忆。

2016年退休后, 花王开始提笔自学水彩水墨画 以排遣时间。孜孜不倦的他, 短短三年的时间 便在因缘际会下获得本次与其他优秀画家一同 联合展出的机会。古稀之年获此荣誉,李先生 除了感激之外,也表示他的画作更多的是对生 活的观察。乡村出生的他对饲养鸡鸭、栽种花 草及自然景致皆很熟悉,加上多年的园艺工作 经验, 李先生对于大自然里的花草动物有了更 深刻的观察。年轻时与母亲一起喂养牲畜及各 种甘榜生活的幸福记忆, 更是推动李先生持续 作画的力量。从创作过程中回忆过往美好,让 怀恋母亲的李先生能有所慰藉。

以水彩水墨画作为退休后的精神寄托,李先生将他出色的表现归咎于自己"偷师"的功力。他说年轻时没有机会接受正规教育,他以多看、多观察的方式累积知识和手艺。注意别人怎么做,然后试着自己依样画葫芦,李先生一点一滴地用双眼观察,再通过自身努力实践,在建筑、园艺乃至如今的书画技艺上都自成一家。"花后"陈女士也表示,她也乐见先生能通过作画保持开朗的心境,但同时也希望他能多休息,不要太过操劳。

从自身对大自然的阅历取材,让这位自称零基础且业余的新锐画家在邻国绽放光芒。本校校长郑玉美教授在观展后表示,在一项会议上无意中晓得以前校园中繁花锦簇,而花草皆由李先生夫妇打理。如今她仅能通过想象勾勒出校园满院芬芳的样子。而退休后的李先生能有一番傲人的作为,郑校长觉得他的经历给予所有人莫大鼓励。

因为工作劳损而被迫退休,如今作画成了李先生生活中的快乐泉源。李先生表示他不敢奢想举办画展,但如今的日子如果没有作画,他也不晓得该如何填补闲暇了。但年纪渐长,他也渐渐感到身不由己,作画间中需要更多的休息,一切仅能量力而为。

"花王"李禹顺先生年近七十依然热衷于为生活注入活力与创造力,愿他能一直保有这份简朴的幸福,而他"再出发"的可贵精神是值得大家学习及散播出去的美丽种子。




校园最友善 行政部门调查

继第40期《今日南方》进行的校园美食调查,本期《今日南方》再次为校园进行另一番调查,收集了229份问卷,为大家揭晓本校最友善行政部门到底花落谁家!



您认为最友善的行政单位 需要具备怎样的性质?




本校的行政部门为数不少,但为大部分学生所熟悉的 或许并不多。更多的行政部门并不会直接与同学们接 触,但行政部门每一决策与安排通常都与学生们息息 相关。此次调查为彰显师生们在平日校园内所见所感 之体会,希望通过此平台予填写者畅所欲言的管道。 另,期望从统计后排列靠前的相关部门中了解个中原 因,为校园行政优化提供一些帮助。

从229份问卷中了解到大家对于"友善行政单位"的定义有一个大致相同的方向。从问卷答案的分析中,"办事效率"、"沟通顺畅"及"积极周到"分别获得88.6%,78.6%及71.6%的问卷对象投选。这显示了大家更注重的是整体的行政效率以及在沟通上的准确无误——你正确接收了我所传达的信息,并且在合理的时效内完整地完成该事项。这或许就是大家认同且追求的"最友善行政单位"。

另外,许多的问卷对象也附上了与"态度"和"友善"相关的其他答案。这显示除了在业务能力的友善之外,行政人员在待人接物上的态度亦为大家所关注。这其实也不难理解,若想有一个和谐健康的校园,保持礼貌与和善的态度便是身在校园内的每一份子都应尽的本分。

您认为校园里哪个行政单位是最友善的?




那么哪个行政单位会是众人投选的"最友善行政单位"呢?问卷对象可以从本校24个行政单位中不分排名地投选三个部门。从问卷分析中可以看见本校图书馆遥遥领先,获得超过一半的问卷对象支持,取得50.7%的投选,排在第一位。而排在第二与第三的分别是物产管理与庶务处(34.9%)和学生事务处(34.1%),获得的票数相差并不多。

不难发现的是,排名前三的单位都是与师生频 密接触的行政部门。排名第一的图书馆负责的 是书籍的借阅与归还以及电子资料库等参考资源的服务,常到馆内温书或借阅书籍的师生一 定对他们不陌生;物产管理与庶务处主要负责 场地租借和设备维修与维护,更多接触到的应 该是校内活动的筹办委员会; 学生事务处则顾 名思义是负责学生社团、奖助学金、学生辅导 等与学生相关的众多事务, 与学生的接触当然 不会少, 但更多的是活跃于社团的学生。

对于为什么会选择上述三个行政单位为"最友善行政部门",问卷对象给予的形容包括友善、耐心、亲切及热情。从问卷的回馈中显示,学生们反映的是相关部门愿意聆听反馈、对话谦逊有礼、处理事务有效率、乐于协助同学解决问题且积极解答疑惑。当然,在反馈中不乏显示因为常接触或因为办活动等因素与该部门相较熟识等原因,但排名前三的部门从中获得的正面评价或许也是所有校园行政部门一同再接再厉的方向。


在整体学校行政人员的满意度方面,55.89%的 反馈是倾向满意的,其中15.72%的反馈选择的 是非常满意。保持中立的投选率也是较高的,一共34.06%,而倾向于不满意的投选率则是 10.04%,其中2.18%选择非常不满意。整体看来 超出一半的问卷对象对于校园行政是近乎满意 的,但还有44.1%的投选是属于中立与不满意的,那我们就得找出其中的原因并加以改善。


因此在问卷中,我们收集到了一些反馈,虽然 其中也有不少表示都挺好、没有意见或者不晓 得该做什么建议,抑或觉得只需持续保持就 行,但我们依旧收到了各方面的反映,其中行 政人员效率与态度以及校园行政系统被提及的 次数最多。

大多数的建议表示校园行政的效率需要提升、加快,并且在许多活动项目的计划上需要提前

通知,以方便安排时间。另一方面,也有反馈 表示行政方面须添加人手,许多项目负责人只 有一位稍显不充足。至于服务态度上的问题, 问卷所收集的资料显示行政人员需要更注意言 语态度,提升沟通技巧,保持礼貌。

回馈中包括许多不愉快经历,其中有一个相较适合分享: "希望老师们能够更亲切友善,当初还是新生的我非常害怕独自到各部门处理东西,因为个人对于老师们的第一印象就是很有教师的威严,有时候觉得老师们的工作已经很不容易了,不敢多问怕麻烦老师。但当老师主动和我微笑,亲切地问我需要什么帮助的时候,就会感觉老师们也不是那么有距离感"。以上这个反馈既反映了学生们的心理以及他们的需求,也同时表达了双向沟通上,情绪与态度是会感染的,愿接下来的大家都能相互表达善意。





至于另一项在反馈中反复出现的便是校园行政 系统与作业系统的更新与提升,但因为多数的 此类反馈没有再延伸说明,故无法指出他们所 想表达的深入想法。仅有少部分问卷反馈表示 系统不完善,若能以电子系统完成申请与活动 安排等会更好。另一项针对行政部门办公室的 翻新与美化同样缺少延伸与说明,或许是想表 达陈旧的行政空间需要美化与布置。

针对建议的部分,还有一项持续出现在反馈中的问题便是组织沟通。问卷收集的反馈表示部门间需要更多的沟通,并且了解自己及彼此的职务,以不至于让前往部门办理事务的师生被指示到错误的部门,兜兜转转后仍旧无法解决问题。此类事情容易被解读为推卸责任等费难,故一开始若有明确分工与足够的了解便能有所避免。此外,与学生投诉管道相关的意见也重复出现,包括在每学期的学生反馈表及学生总会无法有效处理问题,以致投诉无果或投诉无门。从中得出的建议为相关单位需完整地将学生所反映之问题传达予上级,以及提升投诉渠道让意见能传达到可行使权力的相关级

别,从而管理层能真正了解学生需求并做出改 变或进行对话。

以上为针对问卷对象给予的反馈报告,但如果进行友善行政单位调查,校园内学生甚至老师们都不熟悉的行政部门总会处于劣势。因此顾虑到校内不少行政单位是较少,甚至几乎没有与学生互动的,问卷的最后我们针对陌生且想多加了解的部门做了一个调查。整理的结果是"亚洲文艺复兴与跨文化书院"(61.1%)、"创业育成与志业中心"(37.1%)、"华人族群与文化研究所"(34.1%)排在前三,其中排在第一位的"亚洲文艺复兴与跨文化书院"突破半数投票率。

如此"校园最友善行政单位"调查的报告就告一段落,是否有正中你心中想要传达的疑虑或建议?望接下来同学们能抓紧或依循各种正确的管道传达相关的建议,相信无论是行政单位或学术学部都会尽可能地为各位解惑并且持续进步。最后顺祝大家天天和和气气,然后精神饱满地开心上班、快乐学习。

南方大学学院创业育成与志业中心(Entrepreneurial, Incubator, & Cereer Centre, EICC)成立于2005年。初始成立的宗旨除了提供咨询服务及协助创业者推动事业之外,也兼培育具有国际观的人才与促进产业和学术之间的合作。目前,该中心也是学生实习的执行中心。





本校华人族群与文化研究所于9月12日举办"中国社会科学院专家学者谈中国少数民族研究"讲座。与会专家学者有中国社会科学院民族学与人类学研究所副所长方勇教授,主讲"中国少数民族研究概况",以及张军副教授,主讲"中国少数民族语言生活的统一多样性"。是为第77场南方沙龙学术专题讲座。

方勇教授在南方沙龙指出中国政府从1950年代 开始,便将民族区域自治制度纳入《中国人民 政治协商会议共同纲领》,随后写入宪法,在 制度及法律上给予保障。

方教授表示,少数民族的政策发展和文化传承 是"上面千条线,下面一根针",所以如何在县 域落实才是关键,且地方上的政策和基建都需 要做好,包括交通设施、教育普及等方面。


张军教授则在讲座中谈及中国少数民族语言资源的丰富多样性,其中包括55个少数民族使用着130种语言、中国政府当局平等对待各少数民族语言的政策及学习使用国家通用语言文字,以达成统一多样性的实践。张教授说,现在中国已不用"汉化"、"同化"这些字眼,取而代之的是民族间的"交往、交流、交融"。

张军教授表示,中国少数民族语言的保护是自 上而下地由国家主导、专家参与、区域落实。 新近实施的中国语言资源保护工程,采取"国 家统一规划、地方和专家共同实施、鼓励社会 积极参与"的方式,以现代科技手段对包括濒 危语言在内的各民族语言进行保存和保护。


