Workshop: Neck and Shoulder Tuina-Reduction Technique



Faculty of Chinese Medicine at Southern University College successfully conducted a workshop titled "Neck and Shoulder Tuina-Reduction Technique" on April 23, 2025, at Auditorium C4, TCM Building. The session was delivered by Ms. Ho Sing Ying, an experienced practitioner in tuina therapy.

During the workshop, Ms. Ho introduced common issues related to the cervical and shoulder regions and elaborated on effective repositioning techniques. A focal point of her lecture was the "One-Finger Meditation" tuina method, through which she demonstrated key techniques are kneading, rolling, pushing, pressing, rubbing and discussed associated precautions and anatomical considerations.

She emphasized a holistic approach to cervical and shoulder repositioning, which begins with a thorough spinal assessment. Based on the diagnosis, targeted treatment is applied across three key regions which are neck and shoulder area, back, and anterior muscle

groups. Her detailed explanation bridged theory with clinical application, ensuring that participants gained practical insights relevant to real-world practice.

Ms. Ho actively engaged with students, offering in-depth guidance on each technique and its therapeutic rationale. The session concluded with a Q&A segment, during which she patiently addressed students' inquiries and shared practical tips for future clinical applications.

Attendees were reminded of the importance of verifying conference organizers, indexing claims, peer review processes, and official websites before making any submissions.
